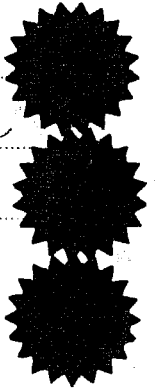

Bolles* an inhabitant of the town of *Hollis* in said County, who is decreed by said Judge to be *an insane person*: Now if the said *James Russell* shall give public notice according to law of his said appointment; shall make or cause to be made and returned to the said Judge, upon oath, within three months from this date, a true and perfect inventory of the estate of his said ward; shall take care, as well of the person as of the estate, both real and personal, of his said ward; shall improve the same frugally and without waste, and apply the annual profits and income thereof for the comfortable maintainance and support of his said ward, and his household and family, if any she have; shall collect the dues of his ward, and pay his just debts out of his property, in the most economical manner, and shall protect the rights of the said ward; and if the said *James Russell* when and so often as he shall be thereto required shall render upon oath a true and just account of his said guardianship, and shall return to said *Dores R.
